

Ricky Road Run 2021 Virtual Race
Terms and Conditions for Entry and Participation

1. In order to register, Participants shall complete the online registration form at <https://www.racesonline.uk/race-entry/rickyroadrun> via RacesOnline with a registration fee of £10, and by doing so the Participant certifies that they have read and accepted these Terms and Conditions.
2. Participants shall choose their own 10-mile route to run within the allocated timeframe stated below.
3. Participants who register to take part in the Ricky Road Run 2021 Virtual Race do so entirely at their own risk and are solely responsible for selecting a safe 10-mile route to run.
4. On entry, participants confirm that they are fit and physically capable of completing the 10-mile run and are not aware of any medical conditions that will negatively affect their health on completion or prevent participation.
5. Affinity Water Limited (“**Affinity Water**”) and its employees, committees, volunteers, sponsors, suppliers and the charities it supports (the “**Relevant Parties**”):
 - a. accept no responsibility for any accidents or injuries sustained by any participant in connection with this event; and
 - b. shall not be held accountable for aggravation to illness or injury sustained due to participation in this event.
6. By agreeing to these Terms and Conditions, the participant:
 - c. waives, releases and discharges the Relevant Parties from any and all claims, liabilities, actions or damages that such participant may have against them in connected with such participant’s participation;
 - d. indemnifies and holds harmless the Relevant Parties directly or indirectly against all liability for any and all injury, loss or damage connected with the participant’s participation; and
 - e. accepts the dangers and hazards of participation (including risk of injury) and accepts full responsibility of its actions.
7. Participants should wear appropriate/hi-viz clothing and footwear and take extra care when running on and off roads or in poor/low light conditions.
8. Participants take full responsibility for their own personal safety and ensuring adequate means of contact/rescue in the event of any incident or injury.
9. Children under the age of sixteen are not permitted to take part.
10. By entering through RacesOnline, you are accepting that RacesOnline and the Affinity Water’s Ricky Road Run Committee will contact you to confirm your entry, keep you updated on the race event and contact you regarding the medals and merchandise should you complete the race.

12. By entering this event, participants consent to their name being used for media publications and announcements of results, unless they have agreed to opt out of the same.
13. Participants must complete the event as one 10-mile course, there is no time limit, but the race cannot be broken down into sections and added together.
14. Participants must complete the event within the allotted time frame of 00:01 Friday 16 July 2021 – 23:59 Monday 2 August 2021.

15. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, all participants agree to adhere to all current Government guidelines that may be in place and practice social distancing where required. Please check the Gov.uk website (<https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus>) before your race attempt and ensure that you are following all applicable rules and guidance.

16. After completing the virtual race, Participants must upload their run details to their Strava account under the "RRR 2021 page" or email a photo/screenshot of your race attempt to rickyroadrun@affinitywater.co.uk. This must include the date and time of when the run was completed. If we do not receive your details either on Strava or through our email, we cannot confirm that a participant has completed the race and therefore they will not receive the finisher's medal and any other commemorative rewards. If you experience any difficulties creating your Strava page or sending us a photo of your efforts, please email rickyroadrun@affinitywater.co.uk.

17. If a Participant does not submit run evidence within 1 month of the finish date (23:59 Monday 2 August 2021), we will not send the finisher's medal and any other commemorative rewards to such participant.

18. The finisher's medal and any other commemorative rewards are not available to any participants outside mainland UK.

19. This event is not a competitive event and as each participant's route will cover different terrain, will occur on different days and be in different locations the times are not comparable and as such, there will be no winner.

20. Affinity Water shall be free to use any images in which it is tagged on social channels or provided by e-mail for any purpose in connection with the event (including marketing and promotion) unless you have opted against photo permission on registration, and the Participant agrees to grant Affinity Water a non-exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable licence, to use, display, publish, transmit, copy, and store, the images for such purposes.

21. The Ricky Road Run 2021 is a charity event, raising funds for WaterAid and KitAid. All proceeds will go to the charities with a 75% and 25% split, respectively.

22. Affinity Water reserves the right to update these terms and conditions at any time prior to the commencement of the event.

23. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales.

Refunds and transfers

1. No refunds will be accepted in respect of the participant fee.
